# Donation to Fire Service Töging

### 25.07.2023 Töging. Spangler's electrical expertise met grateful takers at the Volunteer Fire Department Töging

Since 1873 the Volunteer Fire Department has performed safety tasks for the local population and the surrounding area. In the last years a new fire engine was purchased, so that the troop is increasingly being called out to larger operations in the surrounding area. Many Spangler employees are engaged as fire fighter members and are regularly released by the company to perform their duties.

In addition, the fire department is a pillar of cultural life in Töging, and the fire station is used as a meeting place for many social events. For the upcoming modernization works, Spangler donated for lighting of the building and the courtyard.
