# Experimenting, exploring, marveling – Spangler Kids Day inspires young adventurers

Together with the apprentices, the children built small technical projects such as a brushmounted electric motor, a voltage tester, and the classic dexterity game "Hot Wire." Fun movement challenges and a lively quiz put their team spirit to the test before everyone recharged with a shared pizza lunch after a photo session.

### A tour through the entire company

One highlight of the day was the tour of the production facilities, where the young guests could try out many stations themselves: sitting on a forklift, drilling, completing their first wiring tasks, and weighing themselves together in the warehouse at the end. There was amazement, laughter, and learning at every stop. The children also had the opportunity to visit their parents at their workstations.

"Kids Day was an outstanding success – the children had a fantastic time, and for many parents it was a great relief to have reliable childcare on a school-free day," said Cornelia Hofmann, member of the management team.
